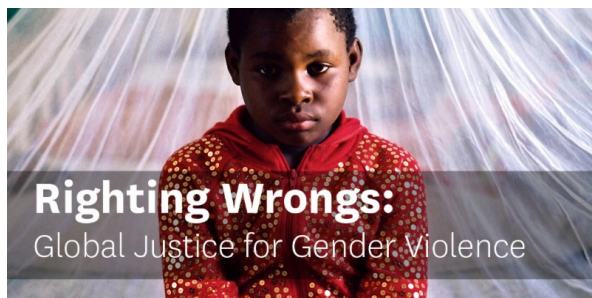
GJC in Vice
