As a little girl I grew up reading about Florence Nightingale. I dreamed that someday I too could help war victims. **"Someday" has happened.**

Last week was the anniversary of the Geneva Conventions. **Because of Florence Nightingale we have laws guaranteeing all war victims equal rights to medical care.**



In just four years, our Global Justice Center team has changed the course of history. **We established, for the first time, that the right of women war victims to medical care includes abortions.**

**Florence, are you there?**

The UN Security Council, the UN Secretary General, the EU, France, Netherlands, and countless organizations around the world agree: **denying abortions for girls and women raped in war is inhuman treatment that must be stopped.**

This is the biggest legal victory of my career. BUT - **a legal victory on paper will not save women's lives.** As **GLOBAL JUSTICE ENFORCERS**, our GJC team is determined that every woman in every war zone gets the medical care she needs, including abortion. **This is her right.**

**We need your help.**

This fall, my goal as a **GLOBAL JUSTICE ENFORCER** is to get President Obama to sign an Executive Order removing the abortion ban attached to all US funding for medical care for girls and women raped in war. **The US must ENFORCE the Geneva Conventions for all war victims, not just men.
